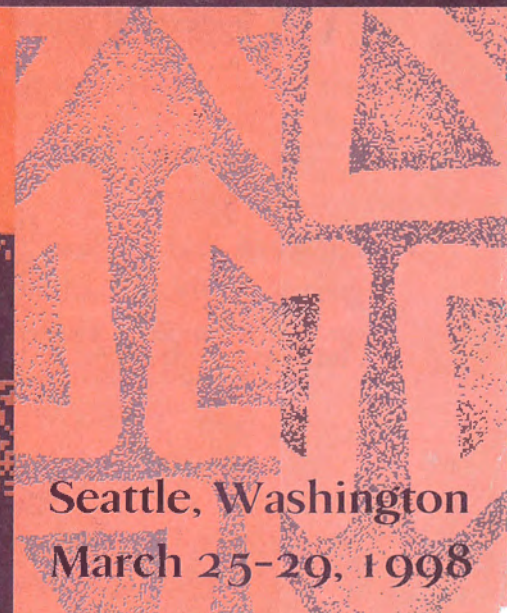
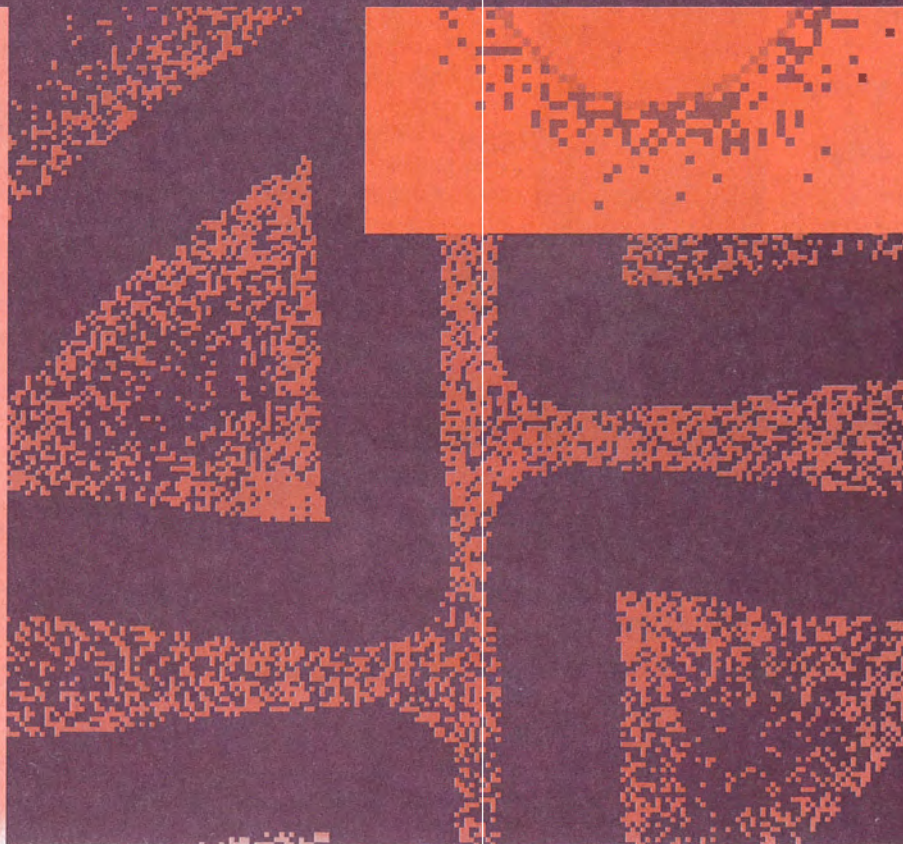




Dear Colleague:
